- 1996-1998. Due to the after math of departure of most NGO's from North Iraq, **MEER** had to change business policy and move their head office to The UAE. From there we succeeded and involved in general trading worldwide in (importing and exporting) electric products and garment shipments to Northern Iraq.
- 1998-2003. Our offices resumed business in 1998 in North Iraq. The company won a contract with the (UN / United Nation) under the oil for food programme. All those contracts were for rebuilding Iraq-Kurdistan region, projects were involved in road constructions, Medical Units (dispensaries), and building Schools with (UN-Habitat). Other contracts with (UNFAO - United Nation Food & Agriculture Organization).
- Transporting agriculture materials, (UNWFP –United Nation World Food Programme) transporting foods. **MEER** also supplied (UNWHO-World Health Organization) and (UNESCO – Unite Nation Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization) with generators, kerosene heaters, carpets and school desks. **MEER** worked in construction projects with (UNITU – United Nation International Telecommunication Union).
